
## Iraq Situation Report: October 11-12, 2014



southern Kirkuk province in particular where the Peshmerga and Iraqi Shi'a militias have been able to target ISIS presence in Tuz Khurmatu and Amerli in Salah ad-Din along the Baghdad-Kirkuk highway. ISIS actions are intended to cut off the highway in order to interrupt the supply line and coordination between the Peshmerga and Iraqi Security Forces (ISF). The Peshmerga are also taking the initiative to target ISIS in Sinjar, but it is unclear how the Peshmerga will capitalize on reported ISIS movement in the Ninewa Plains towns. The assassination of Anbar's police chief, General Ahmed Saddag, will result in at least temporarily disrupting the local police and tribal anti-ISIS effort given Saddag's prominent leadership role. Over the long term, it will be important to watch if Saddag's assassination will galvanize the tribes against ISIS or will permanently affect the effort to blunt the ISIS push to control Anbar province. All of this is particularly significant given the recent calls by Anbar local leaders for U.S. forces to deploy in the province.
