
Control of Terrain in Iraq: July 20, 2015



Trebil crossing: On July 16, 2015, the Interior Ministry (MoI) confirmed that Iraq closed the Trebil border crossing temporarily, but did not elaborate on when the crossing would be reopened. The MoI stated that the decision was taken to deny ISIS the revenue it derives from taxing commercial traffic that transits Trebil crossing. The MoI added that the Safwan crossing with Kuwait will be used in place of Trebil.
