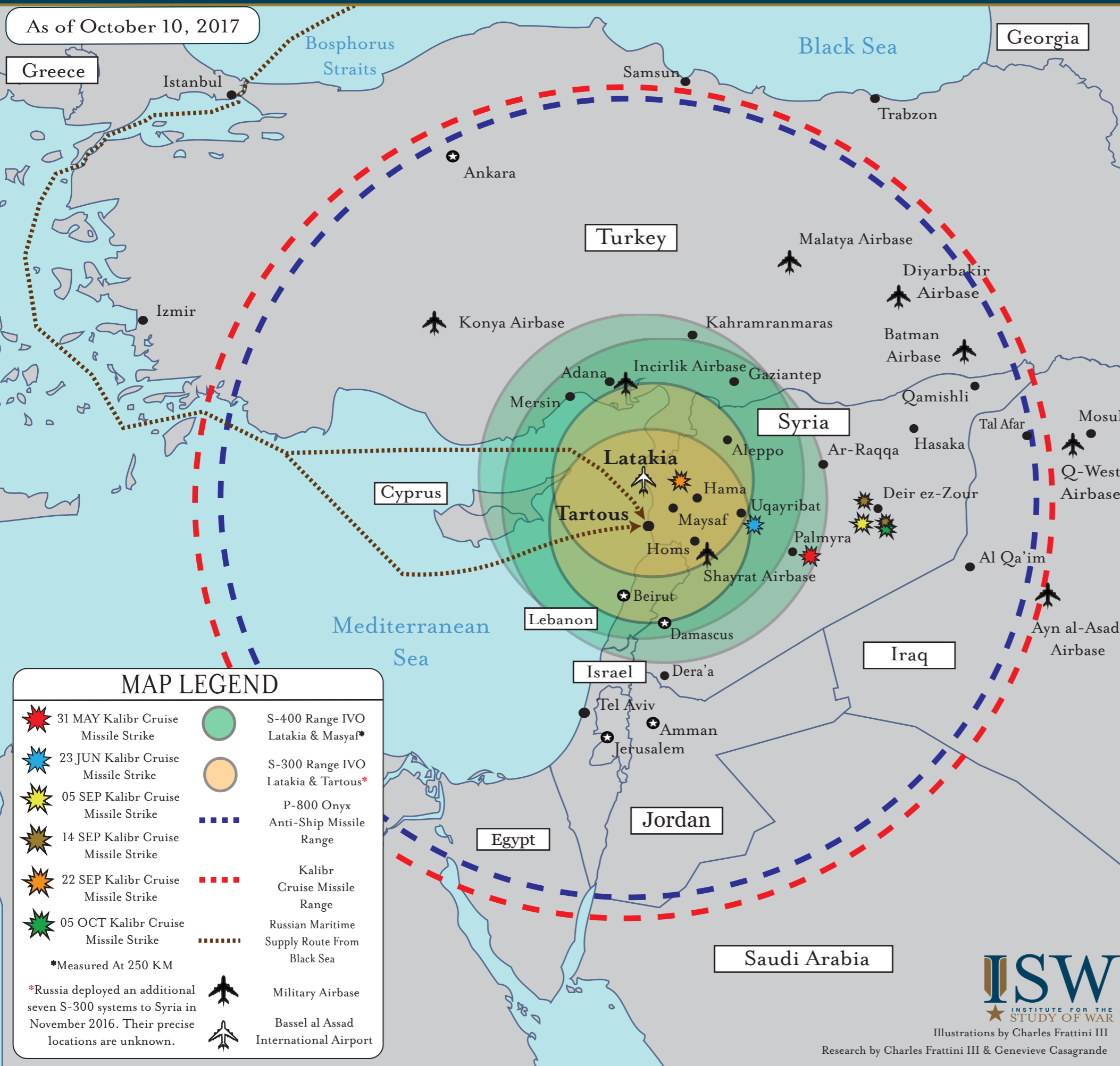


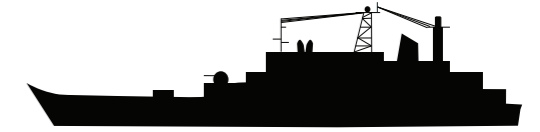
The Russian Black Sea Fleet's Permanent Mediterranean Task Force

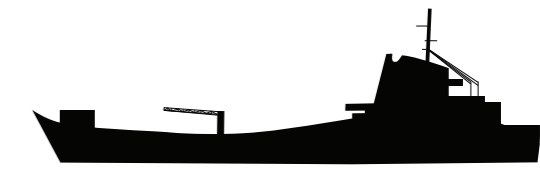


Ships of Russia's Mediterranean Task Force

The Mediterranean Task Force (MTF) is permanently based out of Tartous, Syria and incorporates approximately 15 ships. The MTF additionally incorporates one unidentified Grachonok-class anti-submarine ship, one unidentified fuel tanker, and roughly 4-5 unidentified small support ships.
