

ISIS seized the last regime-controlled border crossing between Syria and Iraq with the capture of the al-Tanf crossing on May 22 following a regime withdrawal. ISIS also launched an attack against the Iraqi side of the crossing at al-Waleed and the post remains contested. Control over the al-Tanf/al-Waleed crossing will enable ISIS forces in central Syria to link more directly with ISIS-held terrain in far-western Anbar Province, including ar-Rutbah. This advance also brings ISIS forces in Syria in close proximity with Jordan's northeastern border.
